OFFICIAL EVENT GUIDELINES

- You must have a Mall of America® issued wristband in order to enter the meet + greet line. A limited number of wristbands will be available in the Rotunda beginning at 11 a.m. on Sunday, August 30.
 Wristbands will be distributed on a first come, first served basis.
- 2. The time at which you line up is at your discretion. Guests will need to remain outside the Level 1, East doors if arriving prior to Mall open. Then after Mall open, guests should relocate and line up in the holding line located near the Rotunda.
- 3. Wristbands are non-transferrable. Each person in your party must be present to receive a wristband. You may not pick up wristbands for another member of your party. People wearing wristbands that have been tampered or altered with will not be allowed through the meet + greet line. No exceptions.
- 4. Adults accompanying minors do not need a wristband to enter the meet + greet line.
- 5. There will be a professional photographer available to take your photo. Guests will have the opportunity to share their photo digitally via Facebook, Twitter, or Email. Actual photos will not be given. No personal photographs with cell phones or digital cameras will be allowed.
- 6. Due to time limitations, **absolutely no autographs will be allowed at this event**. That being said, no memorabilia will be permitted.
- 7. When you enter the meet + greet line, please remain single file. You must stay in line to keep your place. You may leave the line to use the restroom or get food for a short period of time. One person in your party must stay in line at all times.
- 8. If you choose to leave for an extended period of time, you must go to the end of the line when you return.
- 9. No chairs, blankets, pillows, strollers, etc. will be allowed in the line. All bags are subject to search.
- 10. A special needs area will be available for wristbanded guests. If needed, each special needs guest can bring one additional person to this area. Please visit the Mall of America entry table located in the Rotunda upon your arrival, and you will be escorted into this area. Space will be limited and will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

Guidelines are subject to change at any given time at the discretion of Mall of America management for the safety and well being of our guests and tenants. Those who do not comply with event guidelines may not be able to receive a photo.
