OFFICIAL EVENT GUIDELINES

- 1. You must have a Mall of America® wristband in order to enter the Meet + Greet line.
- 2. 2,000 wristbands will be distributed in the Rotunda beginning at 6 a.m. on Friday, October 24. Wristbands are available on a first come first serve basis only.
- 3. The time at which guests enter the official line (located outside the East, Level 1 doors) is at their own discretion. Absolutely no tents will be allowed in line. Chairs, sleeping bags, blankets and pillows must be put away before you enter the Mall. They will not be allowed inside the building. Due to space constraints, guests may be required to wait outside even after the signing has started you will be moved inside as space allows.
- 4. No purchase is required to receive a wristband, however Taylor Caniff merchandise will be available in the Rotunda beginning Friday afternoon.
- 5. Each person in your party must be present to receive a wristband. Wristbands are non-transferable. You may not pick up wristbands for another member of your party.
- 6. Guests wearing wristbands that have been tampered with or altered will not be allowed through the Meet + Greet line. No exceptions.
- 7. Selfies will be allowed at this event, please have your camera ready when you reach the stage.
- 8. When you enter the Meet + Greet line, please remain single file. You must stay in line to keep your place. You may leave the line to use the restroom or get food for a short period of time, but one member of your party must remain in line.
- 9. If you choose to leave for an extended period of time, you must go to the end of the line when you return.
- 10. A special needs Meet + Greet area will be available for guests with wristbands. If needed, each special guest can bring one additional person to this area. Please visit the Mall of America wristband table in the Rotunda upon your arrival and you will be escorted to this area. Space is limited and is filled on a first come first serve basis.

PARENTAL ESCORT POLICY: We welcome all youth to Mall of America®, however on Friday and Saturday evenings youth under 16 must be accompanied by an adult 21 years or older from 4 p.m. until close. One adult may supervise up to 10 youth. Anyone 21 years or younger should be prepared to show a current valid driver's license, state identification card, passport, or Mall of America employee identification card during the Parental Escort Hours.

Your escorts are not required to wait in line, but escorts must remain on-property. You must have a way to contact your escort at all times and if you need to leave the line for any reason you must be accompanied by your escort. Once you have completed the meet and greet, your escort must meet you at the exit of the queue line.

Guidelines are subject to change at any given time at the discretion of Mall of America management for the safety and well being of our guests and tenants. Those who do not comply with event signing guidelines may not be able to receive an Meet + Greet.
