OFFICIAL EVENT GUIDELINES

- 1. You must receive a wristband from Mall of America to meet the McClain Sisters. A limited number of wristbands will be available beginning Sunday, March 11 at 6 a.m.
- 2. "Camping out" is not permitted at Mall of America. No one is allowed to be in line before 5 a.m. on Sunday, March 11.
- 3. You must have a Mall of America issued wristband in order to enter the autograph line in the Rotunda. You must be wearing your wristband to enter the autograph line. There will be no replacements for lost or stolen wristbands.
- 4. As long as you have a wristband, you are able to meet China Anne McClain and the McClain Sisters even if you do not want an autograph. In order to receive an autograph, you must have a copy of the CD, A.N.T. Farm: Music from the Hit TV Show, at the event. No other memorabilia will be signed.
- 5. CDs will be available for sale beginning at 6 a.m. on Sunday, March 11 in the Rotunda.
- 6. No photos can be taken on stage. All cameras and cell phones are to be put away once you reach the stage stairs.
- 7. Personalization will not be allowed.
- 8. Adults accompanying minors do not need a wristband to enter the autograph line.
- 9. Wristbands are non-transferable. People wearing wristbands that have been tampered or altered will not be allowed through the autograph line. Adults may not obtain a wristband for a child, child must be present. No exceptions.
- 10. No chairs, blankets, pillows, strollers, etc. allowed in the autograph line area. All bags are subject to search.
- 11. When you enter the autograph line, please remain single file. You must stay in line to keep your place. You may leave the line to use the restroom or get food for a short period of time. One person in your party must stay in line at all times.
- 12. If you choose to leave for an extended period of time, you must go to the end of the line when you return.
- 13. Everyone must be in line no later than 9 a.m. on Sunday, March 11.
- 14. A special needs viewing area will be available for guests. If needed, each special needs guest can bring one additional person to this area. Please visit the Mall of America information table located in the Rotunda upon your arrival, and you will escorted into this area. Space will be limited and will be filled on a first come, first served basis.
